



EAA Doctoral Scholarship

Purpose:

Doctoral Scholarship(s) sponsored by the Educational Audiology Association are awarded on an annual basis. This financial assistance is available to practicing educational audiologists who are pursuing a doctoral degree in an area that may advance the field of educational audiology and/or benefit educational audiologists. A maximum of three (3) scholarships will be awarded annually. The amount of each scholarship can range from \$500 to \$1,000 USD.

Requirements:

- The applicant must be a member of EAA, practicing as an educational audiologist and be matriculated in an official doctoral program. The applicant must complete the application and submit all supporting documentation.
***NOTE: Rolling submissions will be accepted all year long.**

- The completed application should be mailed to EAA headquarters at 700 McKnight Park Drive, Suite 708, Pittsburgh, PA 15237 or the entire application can be emailed to admin@edaud.org with email title "EAA Scholarship App. - (last name)."

- **Proof of Enrollment**

The applicant must provide proof of enrollment in an official doctoral program. Please include with your application a letter from the program director that documents your enrollment in the doctoral program.

- **Essay**

Provide not more than a 500-word response to each of the following questions. Prepare each response on a separate sheet of paper and enclose them with this application.

Essay #1: *How do you feel that pursuing a doctoral degree will enhance your effectiveness as an educational audiologist?*

Essay #2: *Who has been the most influential person in your career as an educational audiologist and why?*

Additional Requirements

- **Attach a copy of your resume and include three letters of support/recommendation.**
