How to Play

Items to Find

1. Hearing Aid/Cochlear Implant/Bone Anchored Hearing Aid

A small device worn behind, in the ear, on the side of the head, or on a headband that makes sounds audible for someone with hearing loss.

2. Remote Microphone (Roger or DM System)

A wireless microphone the teacher wears so their voice goes directly to a student's hearing aids, cochlear implants, or bone anchored hearing aid.

3. Soundfield System

Speakers in a classroom that make the teacher's voice louder for everyone — look for small speakers on walls or the ceiling.

4. Charging Station or Drying Kit

A special case or box used to charge or dry out hearing aids and cochlear implants overnight.

5. Listening Check Equipment

Tools like a listening stethoscope or a hearing aid test box that the educational audiologist uses to make sure devices are working.

6. Closed Captions or Visual Alert

Words on a screen during a video, or a flashing light instead of a bell — these help students who are deaf or hard of hearing.
